Heritage Flight Museum moves again

BELLINGHAM - The Heritage Flight Museum is moving again after finding a longer-term facility on the main road to Bellingham International Airport.

Museum directors say they have leased a new hangar from Tek Construction at 4165 Mitchell Way. In order to complete the move quickly, the museum will not be holding monthly open houses for the rest of the year. Museum backers say they hope eventually to get some land at the airport for a permanent building.
